On Field

- The Umpire's decision is final.
- Dress in appropriate cricket clothing, i.e. club shirt, Team representative shirt.
- Play by the Rules and the Spirit of the Game.
- Play to your best ability, not only for yourself but also for your team and club.
- Let your coach know if you are unable to attend training or play a game.

Off Field

- Represent Leschenault Cricket Club the best way possible, especially in Development/Representative teams.
- Approach training as it is a game, remember the harder you train, the harder you will play.
- Treat club gear with respect.
- Don't use Social Media as a way of talking negatively about the club, players, coaches, parents, opposition teams and players.
